RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The Landowners and Officials have taken all reasonable steps to ensure the health and safety of all present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and MUST obey the instructions of the Organisers and Officials. No responsibility can be taken for theft, loss, damage, accident, illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles whilst attending the show.
- 2) Persons attending do so at their own risk.
- 3) A correctly fitting hat MUST be worn with a properly adjusted chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted. Correct riding dress must be worn and correct footwear MUST be worn.
- 4) The Organisers reserve the right to cancel/alter the events/class or refuse admission.
- 5) Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- 6) No entry will be accepted without the correct fee. Cheques should be made payable to DILWYN VILLAGE SHOW.
- 7) Any misuse of the whip, failure to obey an order from a judge or steward, or discourteous behaviour to any other showground personnel may result in dismissal from the showground.
- 8) All horse must remain at a walk at all times outside the practice area or arenas.
- 9) Please respect the hospitality of the landowner and dispose of litter in bins provided or take it home
- 10) **NO LUNGING.**
- 11) Please do not clean out your box/trailer on the field.
- 12) The show officials recommend that if horses are to be left unattended when not being ridden, they are secured inside trailers/horse boxes.
- 13) If a rider falls whilst completing, this constitutes elimination in that class.
- 14) Ages on day of show.
- 15) Lead rein competitors must remain so for the whole of the show.
- 16) The Judges decision is final.
- 17) The committee reserve the right to cancel the show at short notice in adverse weather and ground conditions.
